ORDER OF THE ARROW

FIRST-YEAR ARROWMAN AWARD CRITERIA

A First-Year Arrowman (FYA) who completes the requirements below, prior to the next year's corresponding Ordeal, will be awarded the Portage Lodge First-Year Arrowman Award – as the FYA works to earn this award, he/she will meet new friends, find new interests, and get a head start on the path of service that is central to the Order of the Arrow (OA). Only a FYA, who joined the Portage Lodge, can earn this prestigious award. Below are listed the requirements for this award. Except for #3 and #4a, all requirements must be initialed by the Lodge Chief, a Lodge Vice Chief, Lodge Adviser, Staff Adviser, Chapter Chief, or Chapter Adviser.

- _____ 4b) Participate in a Camp Work Day or Chapter Day of Service (Ordeal service weekends do not count)

Complete three of the following:

 - 1st - Elangomat chair must sign _____
 - 2nd - Elangomat chair must sign _____
- _____ 6) Attend the Lodge Leadership Development (LLD) conference or Arrowman Leadership Training Conference (ALTC)
- _____ 7) Attend the Lodge New Member Dinner
- _____ 8) Attend the Section Conclave
- _____ 9) Attend the National OA Event
- _____ 10) Attend four chapter meetings (other than meetings held during lodge events)
